Project Description
The Surfside Segment - Miami-Dade County Shore Protection Project is located between DEP monuments R31 and R38 in Miami-Dade County. Since 1978, the 1.3 mile long segment part of the Beach Erosion Control (BEC) and Hurricane Protection Project (HP) has received periodic nourishments and numerous projects to address localized erosional hotspots. Additional nourishments have occurred in August 1999 and April 2014, with the most recent completed in February 2020. The requested funds are for the permit-required post-construction monitoring of the latest nourishment project completed by the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) in 2020. Staff have determined that 100% of the project is eligible for state cost sharing.
