Project Description
The Ft. Pierce Shore Protection Project is located between DEP monuments R34 and R46 in St. Lucie County. Initial restoration occurred in 1971. Including this initial restoration and 17 subsequent nourishments, approximately 7.08 million cy of sand have been placed on the beach as of April 2023. Sand used in these nourishments has been sourced from an offshore borrow area and dredged material from maintenance of the Fort Pierce Inlet navigation channel. St. Lucie county anticipates the next federal nourishment occurring in winter 2024/spring 2025. The requested funds are for Monitoring. Staff have determined that 100% of the project is eligible for state cost sharing.
