A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF VOLUSIA
REQUESTING INLET MANAGEMENT GRANT ASSISTANCE
FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION
BEACH MANAGEMENT FUNDING ASSISTANCE PROGRAM
FY2024/25 LOCAL GOVERNMENT FUNDING REQUEST

THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF VOLUSIA, in order to seek funding assistance for beach monitoring of Volusia County and Ponce DeLeon Inlet, RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Support for Beach Monitoring within Volusia County. The Council acknowledges its statutory obligation to execute the Ponce DeLeon Inlet Management Plan. In conjunction with the State of Florida's statewide, comprehensive beach management plan and its continued support for activities which will bypass sand to the downdrift beach associated with Ponce DeLeon Inlet.
2. Local Sponsorship. The County agrees to serve as the local sponsor for the implementation of the Ponce DeLeon Inlet Management Plan.
3. Local Funding Source. The County has sufficient budgeted reserves to meet and pay for the local match requirement of the project. Although it is not expected to be necessary, the County also has the ability to levy ad valorem property taxes in an amount needed to fund the local match requirements of the project.
4. Affirmation of Authority to Apply for Funding. The Council authorizes, and hereby affirms all acts already taken by its County Manager, George Recktenwald, and engineers, Taylor Engineering, Inc. regarding application for Beach Management Funding Assistance for execution of the Inlet Management Plan from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection, and directs application for such funding, including such actions as may be required to obtain such assistance.
