

Regional Long-Term Recovery Strategy

Potential Tasks

1. Establish a Regional Overview Committee (Organize, role of members);
2. Provide historical overview of past disasters in the region;
3. Define the role of the regional planning council in long-term recovery;
4. Define criteria to determine regional long-term recovery topic areas;
5. Identify potential data sources;
6. Document regional scale issues;
7. Based on analysis of data determine whether issues are common to more than one local government, or (e.g., transportation, housing, economic, environmental, social health-related);
8. Assess each in terms of deficiencies, gaps, duplication in light of long-term recovery;
9. Identify the particular issue or does impact the ability of the region's resilience to recover from a major or catastrophic event disaster event;
10. Develop long-term recovery options;
11. Develop list of regional resources to assist in recovery;
12. Take information derived from the above tasks and create regional long-term recovery strategies for the WFRPC and ARPC.
