The City of Milton's Quinn Street Marina will provide local boaters with access to public waterways. Boating access provides the primary infrastructure upon which many types of secondary activities may be enjoyed. Myriad water-dependent activities include fishing, water-skiing, and simply cruising local waterways, providing not only recreational values, but also substantial economic value to the local and state economies.

The newly constructed marina will also be the focal point for the city's Riverwalk. It will grant locals access to additional parking, accessible facilities and provide another access point to the boardwalk for the city's largest attractions.

This proposal seeks funding to modify the Quinn St. Marina. Modifications will include the construction of a new building that is ADA compliant with handicap accessible parking and restroom facilities. Construction and other work will be accomplished using Best Management Practices which meet or exceed local, state and federal environmental standards.
