



**St. Andrews State Park
Shell Island**

Accessible only by boat, Shell Island is a 690-acre undeveloped barrier island, with diverse natural community types, including maritime hammock, coastal dune lake, and extensive beach dune. The island is ideal wildlife viewing and secluded beach recreation, with uninterrupted viewsheds of white sand beach and coastal grassland, while the bay side offers scenic views of an intricate estuarine shoreline. Proposed facilities on Shell Island will provide necessary amenities for visitors and promote safe and low-impact access from St. Andrew Bay to the Gulf of Mexico.
