



## T.H. Stone Memorial St. Joseph Peninsula State Park

T.H. Stone Memorial St. Joseph Peninsula State Park is a flagship of Northwest Florida, offering many amenities for recreation as well as extensive protected areas, including the 1,900-acre wilderness preserve. Proposed improvements focus on renovation of existing facilities to meet the needs of growing visitation. New development is recommended to improve the visitor experience at existing use areas, provide multimodal access through the park, and restore the natural hydrology of a significant wetland area.
