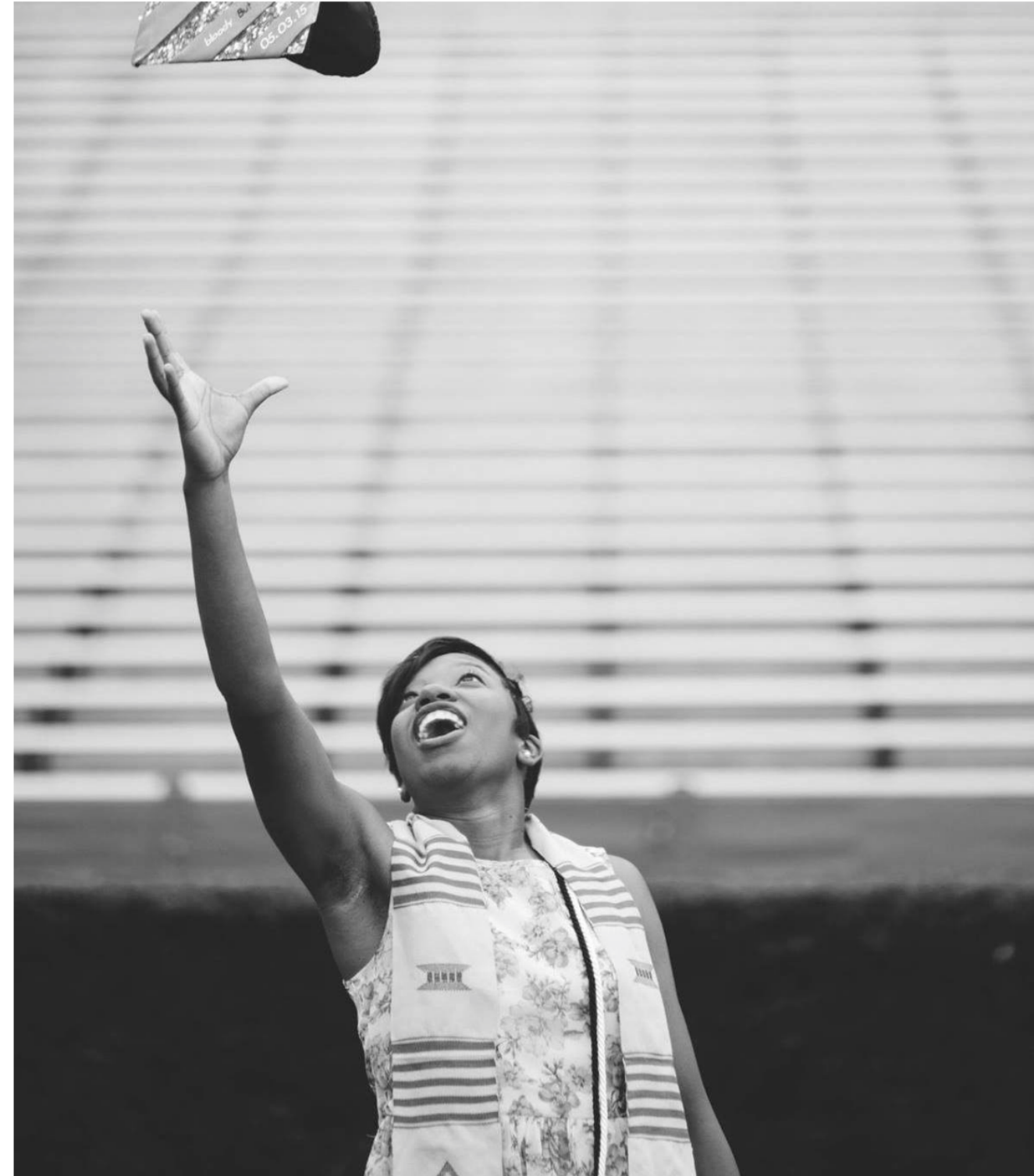


Treasure Hunting!

JFG is a robust program designed to provide wrap around services to students who have significant barriers to success. Our Treasure Hunters provide year round support to ensure students are working their plan.

Skills Mastery : Jobs for Florida's Graduates (JFG) is a competency-based program with over 1000 hours of instruction. Services are rooted in the interpersonal skills employers and colleges value. A robust data tracking system allows for real-time information on students, services and outcomes.

Academic & Career Development : JFG Treasure Hunters maintain an average student / teacher ratio of 50:1, which allows them to invest significant time in helping students develop an individual development plan designed to navigate around barriers and work toward academic, personal and professional goals.

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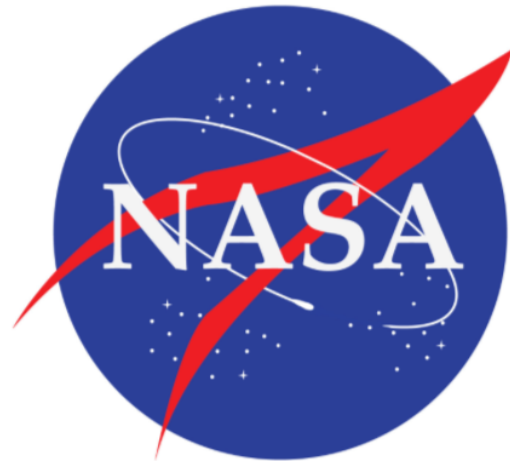
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
