Alligator Lake Coastal Dune Lake Hydrologic Restoration

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would reduce pollution and hydrologic degradation in coastal waters within the Choctawhatchee Bay Watershed by removing culverts under County Road 30A in Walton County that presently acting as barriers separating the north and south portions of Alligator Lake rather than allowing the exchange of fresh and Gulf waters. A bridge would be constructed across Alligator Lake to help restore tidal exchange and remove barriers to fish and wildlife movements. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection would be the implementing Trustee for this project.

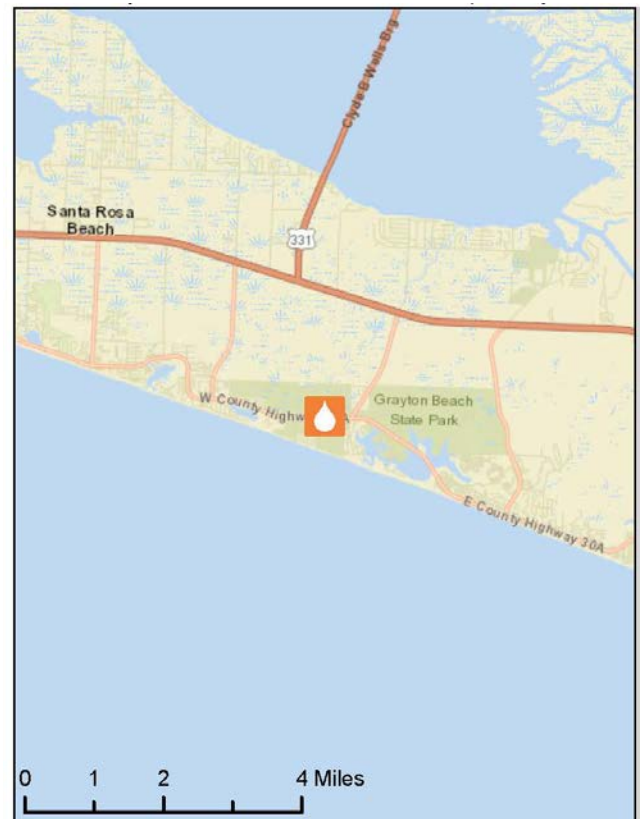
