Gulf Islands National Seashore (FL) Beach and Dune Habitat Protection

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project aims to protect and restore beach habitat at Gulf Islands National Seashore in Florida and associated wildlife. Project activities include temporarily closing sensitive areas to prevent trampling and disturbance, development of public outreach materials to educate visitors on the habitat and wildlife, law enforcement patrols to monitor and control vehicle speeding rates and reduce vehicle collisions with wildlife, predator management and monitoring activities. The U.S. Department of the Interior would be the implementing Trustee for this project.

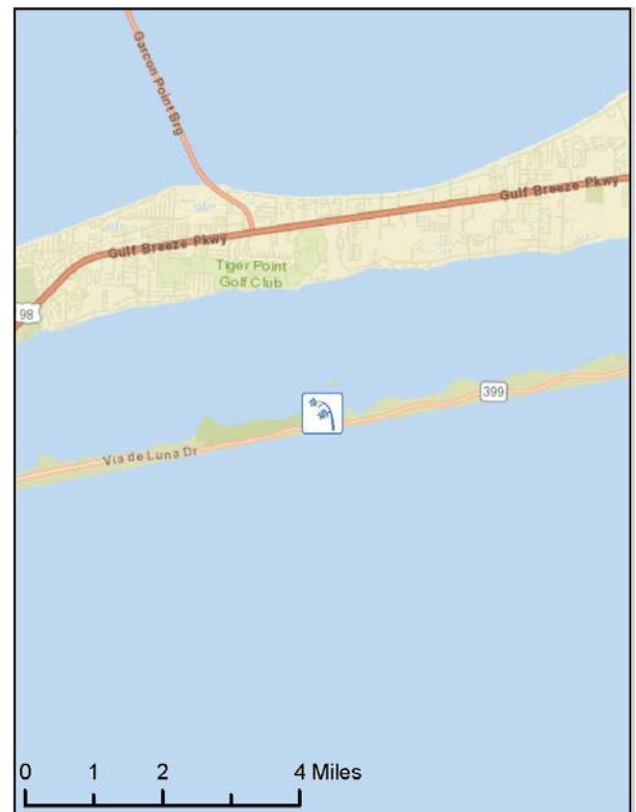
