PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project includes activities to collect information on the location of and to treat five of the most problematic invasive plant species in Fort Pickens, Santa Rosa, and Perdido Key areas of Gulf Islands National Seashore in Florida to protect and conserve habitat and wildlife resources. This project would also include an evaluation of past and current treatment methods and development of a Treatment Action Plan. The U.S. Department of the Interior would be the implementing Trustee for this project.

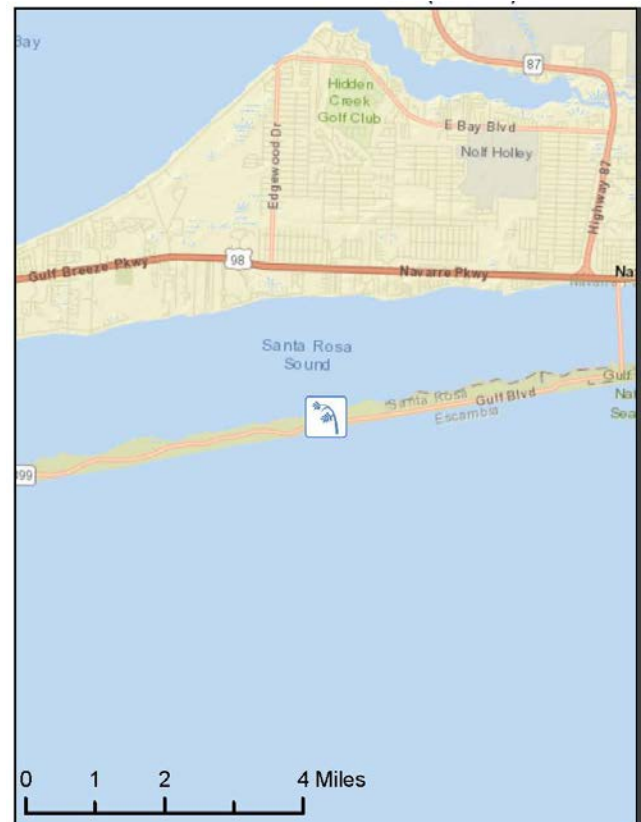
