PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project involves the rehabilitation of recreational facilities at the Okaloosa Unit of Gulf Islands National Seashore including re-vegetation efforts and rehabilitating a boat ramp, floating pier, restroom, lift station, electrical systems, parking area, RV sites, picnic areas, gates, boardwalks, and fencing. This project would enhance recreational opportunities and experiences at the Okaloosa Unit. The U.S. Department of the Interior would be the implementing Trustee for this project.

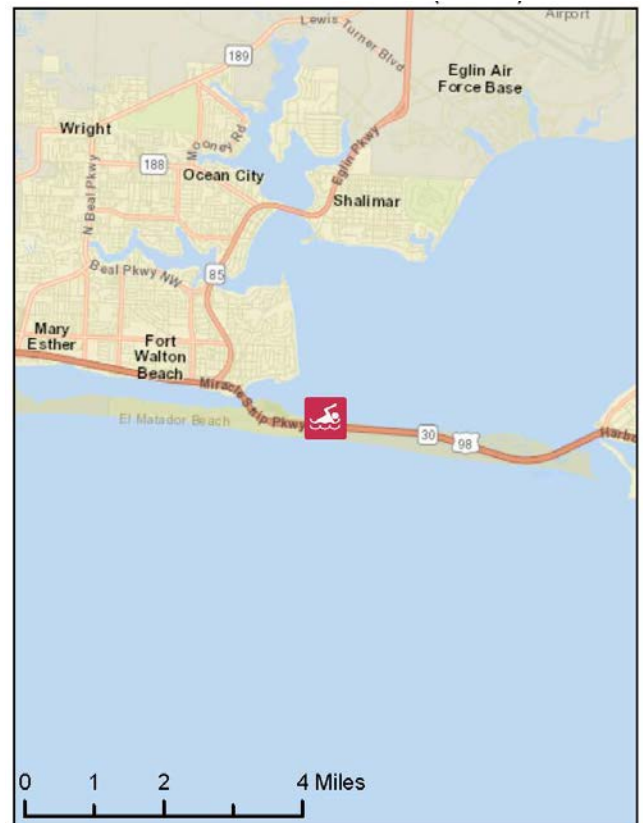
