Lower Suwannee River Watershed – Nutrient Reduction

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would improve water quality by reducing sediment and nutrient (phosphorus and nitrogen) loads to Lower Suwannee River watershed in three HUC12 watersheds: Long Pond, Long Pond Slough, Manatee Springs through the development and implementation of conservation plans on agricultural lands. These plans aim to address nutrient and sediment runoff through the implementation of conservation practices (CPs) and require identifying willing landowners to participate. The U.S. Department of Agriculture would be the implementing Trustee for this project.

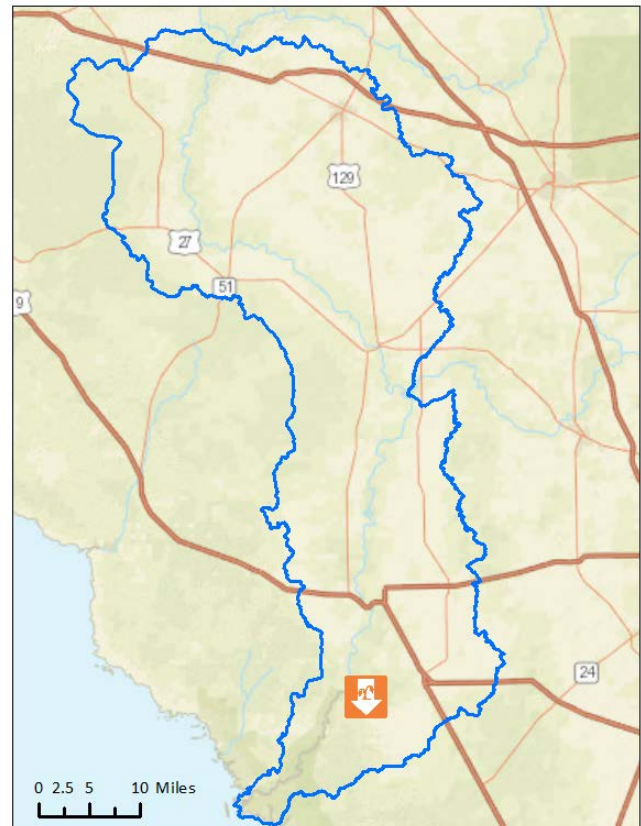
