Pensacola Bay and Perdido River Watersheds – Nutrient Reduction

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would improve water quality by reducing sediment and nutrient (phosphorus and nitrogen) loads to Pensacola Bay and Perdido River watersheds in two HUC12 watersheds: Sandy Hollow-Pine Barren Creek and Moore Creek through the development and implementation of conservation plans on agricultural lands. These plans aim to address nutrient and sediment runoff through the implementation of conservation practices (CPs) and require identifying willing landowners to participate. The U.S. Department of Agriculture would be the implementing Trustee for this project.

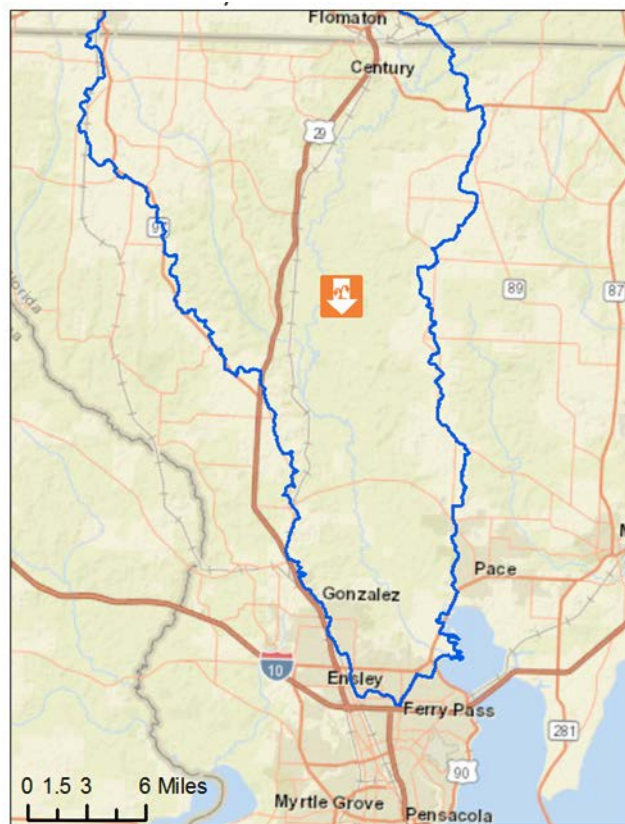
