Pensacola Bay Unpaved Roads Initiative (planning and design)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project aims to collect information that would be helpful for improving water quality in the Pensacola Bay Watershed. The project would include assessing and identifying unpaved stream crossings contributing the largest sediment loads to the watershed, and to develop 30% design plans of site-specific solutions at a minimum of 15 priority locations to eliminate or reduce sediment loading to water resources and associated habitats. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection would be the implementing Trustee for this project.

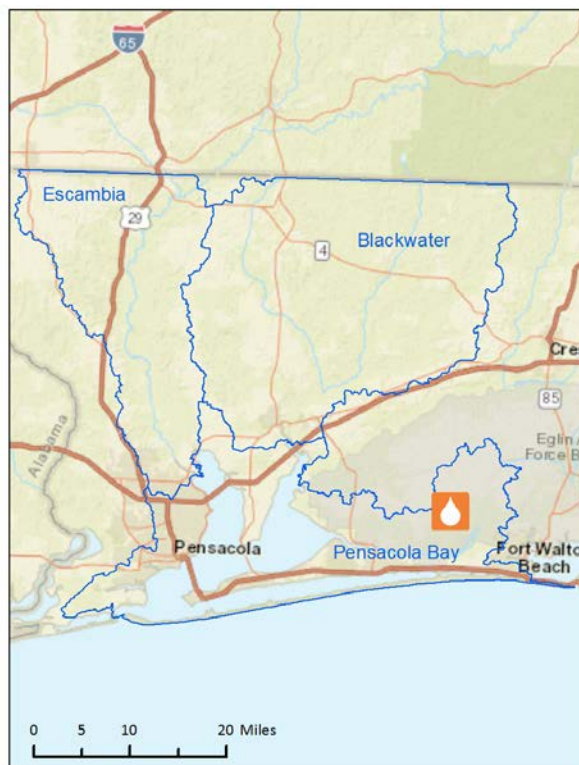
