

Florida Restoration Area

Rattlesnake Bluff Road and Riverbank Restoration

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would reduce erosion and sediment loads to the Yellow River and Pensacola Bay by stabilizing roads and replacing deteriorating and/or inadequate culverts at up to six priority stream crossings identified along Rattlesnake Bluff Road in Santa Rosa and Okaloosa counties. The project includes re-assessment and selection of six from the existing 13 priority stream crossings along Rattlesnake Bluff Road and planning, design, and construction of culvert replacements. The U.S. Department of the Interior would be the implementing Trustee for this project.
