

Florida Restoration Area

Northeast Florida Coastal Predation Management

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would implement predation management measures at a minimum of four critical nesting sites in Northeast Florida to increase reproductive success and population size for several *Deepwater Horizon*-injured bird species such as American oystercatchers, least terns, black skimmers, and Wilson's plovers. Banded bird resightings indicate that there is connectivity between Atlantic and Gulf Coast bird populations. The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission would be the Implementing Trustee for this project.

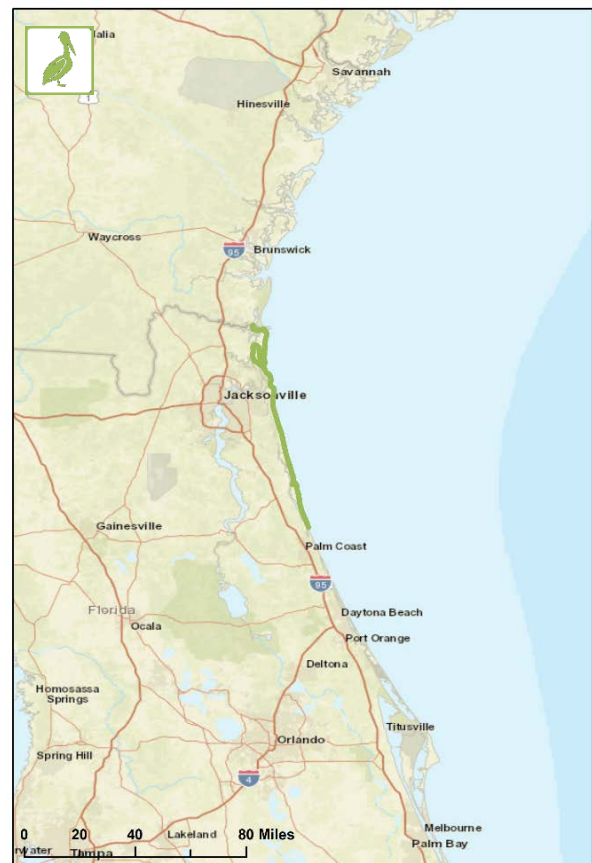
