Pensacola Beach Fort Pickens Road Wildlife Lighting Retrofits

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would enhance sea turtle nesting beach habitat by replacing 170+ streetlights along 2 miles of Fort Pickens Road in Gulf Islands National Seashore. The wildlife-friendly, amber, light-emitting diode (LED) lighting upgrades would reduce light pollution on beaches, which can affect nest site selection, disorient nesting turtles, and interfere with the ability of hatchlings to find the sea. The U.S. Department of the Interior would be the Implementing Trustee for this project.

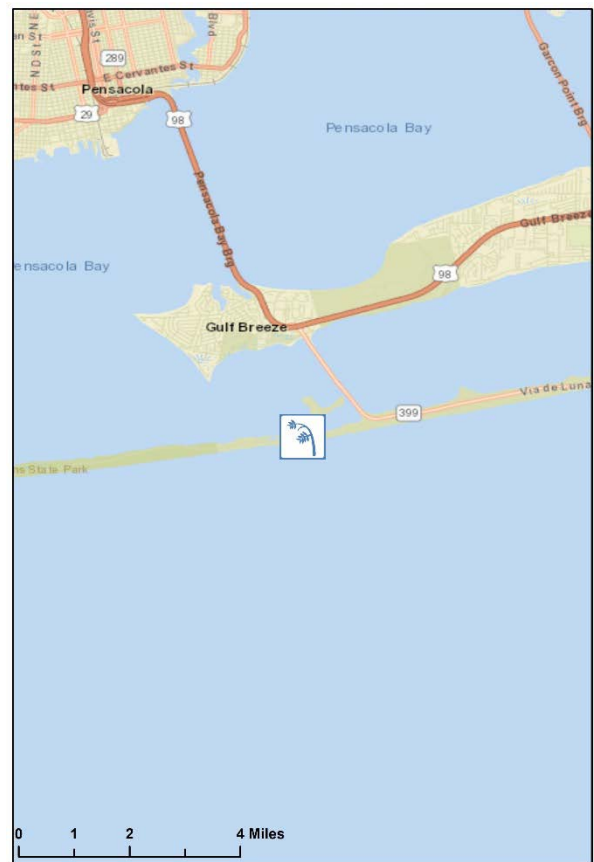
