St. Vincent National Wildlife Refuge Access and Recreational Improvements through Acquisition at Indian Pass

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would acquire a 10 to 15-acre parcel at Indian Pass for inclusion in the St. Vincent National Wildlife Refuge and enhance recreational amenities (parking, the first SVNWR visitor contact station in sight of the island, and a kayak launch) at the site. This project would secure boating access to SVNWR for habitat protection and management activities in perpetuity. The U.S. Department of the Interior and Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission would be the Implementing Trustees for this project.

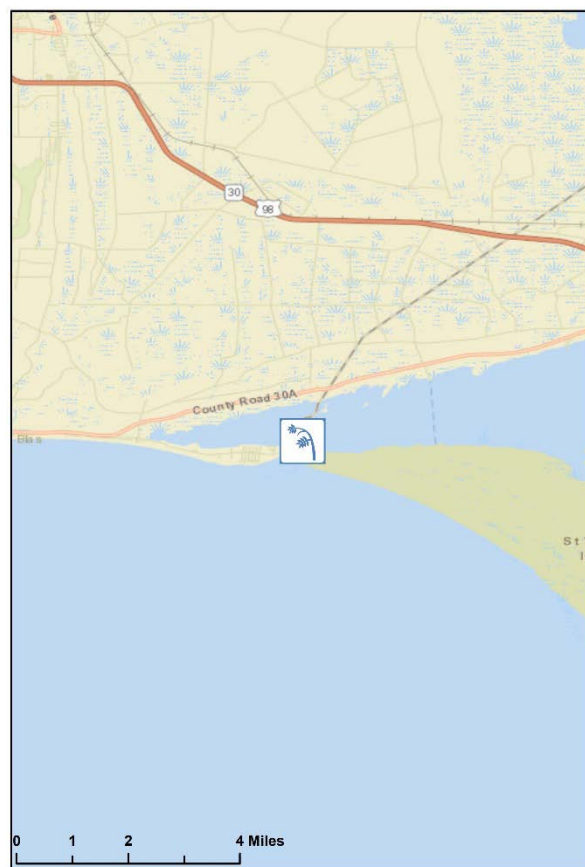
