St. Andrews State Park Improvements

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project includes actions to improve access to use areas in St. Andrews State Park and constructing additional recreational amenities. Improvements would be made to the entrance area, other roadways, and parking lots to facilitate access and egress of vehicles at the ranger station for day-use visitors and campers and to help alleviate traffic congestion during peak visitation periods; new amenities at the Lagoon Use area include a paddle-craft launch, pavilions, restroom, a loop trail, and sidewalks connecting amenities. The Florida Department of Environmental Protection would be the implementing Trustee for this project.

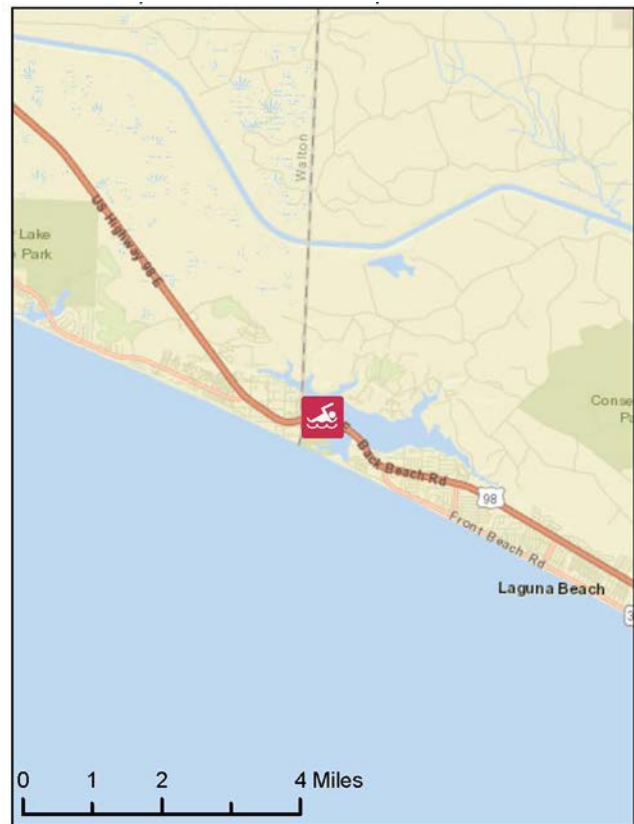
