**FINAL ORDER MODIFYING
CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION**

SITING COORDINATOR

On April 28, 1998, the Governor and Cabinet, sitting as the Siting Board, issued a final order approving certification for the existing Sam O. Purdom Generating Station, including a new Unit 8. That certification order approved the existing site as well as construction and operation of a new combined cycle combustion turbine unit and its associated facilities, located in Wakulla County, Florida.

On August 6, 2001, the City of Tallahassee filed a request to amend the Conditions of Certification pursuant to Section 403.516(1)(b), Florida Statutes (F.S.); Rule 62-17.211, Florida Administrative Code; and Condition of Certification Number XI. This request addressed the addition of a water pipeline across the certified site and the use of treated industrial wastewater from St. Marks Powder, a division of General Dynamics Corporation, in the Purdom Unit 8 cooling tower.

On October 31, 2001, revised copies of the proposed modifications were made available for public review and all parties to the original proceeding were furnished copies of the Notice of Intent to Issue Proposed Modification of Power Plant Certification along with a copy of the Proposed Final Order. On November 9, 2001, a Notice of Intent to Issue Proposed Modification of Power Plant Certification was published in the Florida Administrative Weekly. All parties to the original certification proceeding have 45 days from the issuance of the notice by mail to such party's last address of record in which to object to the requested modification. Failure of any of the parties to file a response constitutes a waiver of objection to the requested modification. Any person who is not already a party to the certification proceeding and whose substantial interests

are affected by the requested modification has 30 days from the date of publication of the public notice in the Florida Administrative Weekly to object in writing. If no objections are received, then a Final Order approving the modification shall be issued by the Department. If objections are raised and agreement cannot be subsequently reached, then pursuant to §403.516(1)(c), F.S., the applicant or the Department may file a petition for modification seeking approval for those portions of the request for modification to which written objections were timely filed. No written objections to the proposed modifications have been received by the Department. Accordingly, in the absence of any timely objection,

IT IS ORDERED:

The proposed changes to the Conditions of Certification for the City of Tallahassee Purdom Generating Station are APPROVED. Pursuant to Section 403.516(1)(b), F.S., the Conditions of Certification for the City of Tallahassee's Purdom Generating Station are MODIFIED as follows:

XXVI. CONSTRUCTION OF INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER PIPELINE

A. Construction Requirements

The construction of the industrial wastewater pipeline across the Purdom Generating Station site shall be performed in a manner designed to minimize the temporary disturbance to any wetlands and be performed pursuant to the alignment and methods described in the construction plans submitted to the Department on August 6, 2001.

B. Restoration of Wetland Impacts

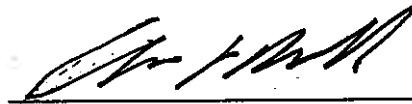
The City shall restore all wetland impacts associated with the construction of the industrial wastewater pipeline across the Purdom Generating Station site pursuant to the Restoration Plan submitted to the Department on August 6, 2001. The City shall monitor all restored wetland areas pursuant to the Restoration Plan submitted to the Department on August 6, 2001.

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Any party to this Final Order has a right to seek judicial review of this Final Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes by filing a Notice of Appeal, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection in the Office of General Counsel, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, M.S. 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal, accompanied by the applicable filing fees, with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date this Final Order is filed with the Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection.

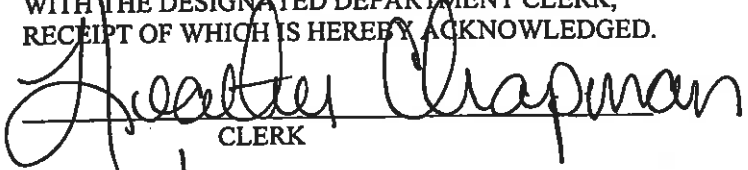

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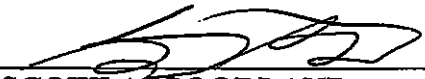
