IV-1) The Department of State, Division of Historical Resources concurs with the conclusions presented in Appendix 10.7.2 of the SCA, A Desktop Cultural Resource Survey of the FPL Port Everglades SCA Parcel, Broward County, Florida (September 2011), which indicated that no known or recorded historical properties are located within or adjacent to the existing Port Everglades power plant. However, we do request that additional inventory and evaluation of any buildings or structures associated with the 1961 power plant be identified and documented on a Florida Master Site File Resource Group form and submitted to this office, as well as a Survey Log form for the 2011 desktop report. The 1961 power plant will be evaluated by this agency to determine if it is of historical significance. The two requested forms and desktop report at completion of the application review will be forwarded to the Florida Master Site File.

RESPONSE:

Comment acknowledged. FPL will coordinate with the Division of Historical Resources (DHR) and prepare an inventory and evaluation of the buildings/structures associated with the 1961 power plant. These buildings/structures will be documented on Florida Master Site File Resource Group forms and Survey Logs and submitted to DHR for inclusion in the Florida Master Site File.
