

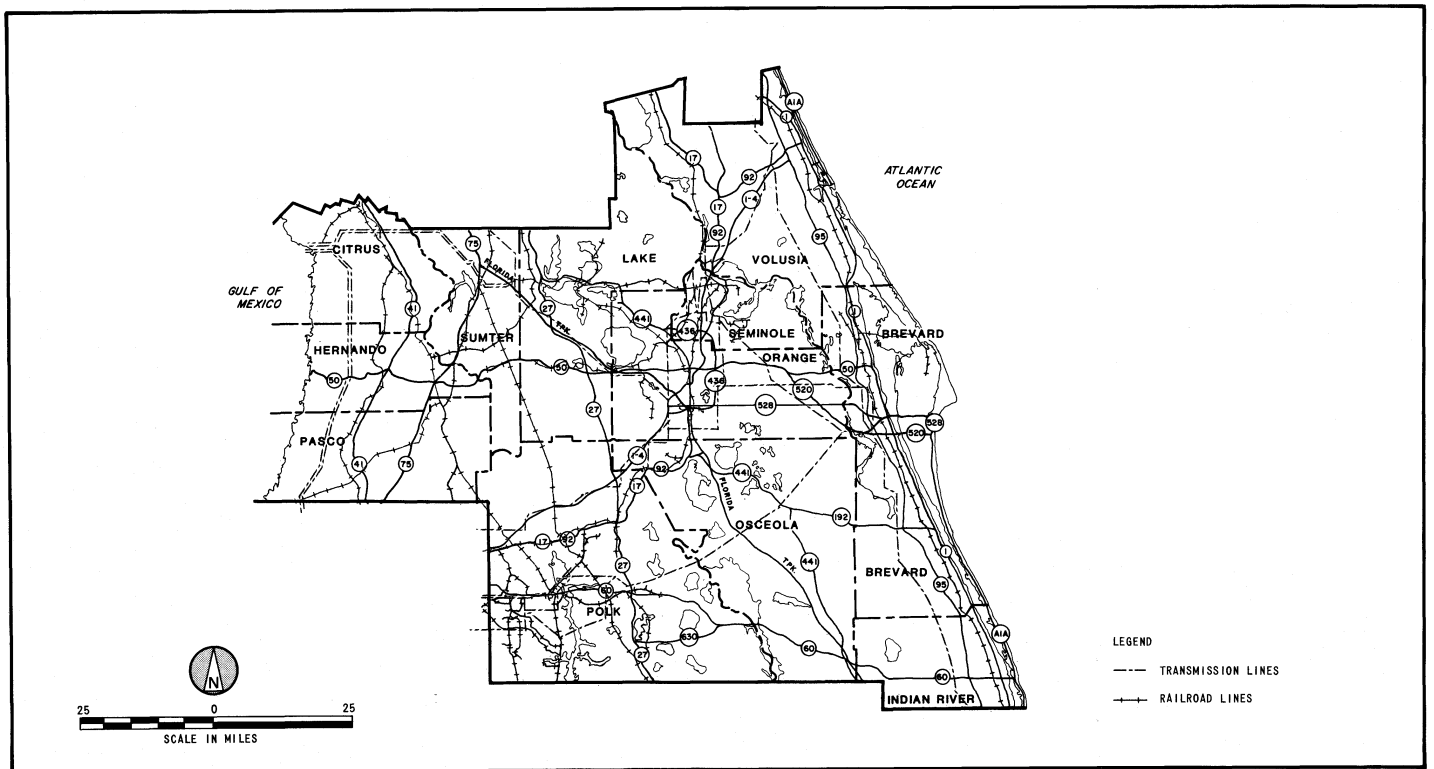


FIGURE 8.1-5. EXISTING TRANSMISSION LINES AND RAILROADS

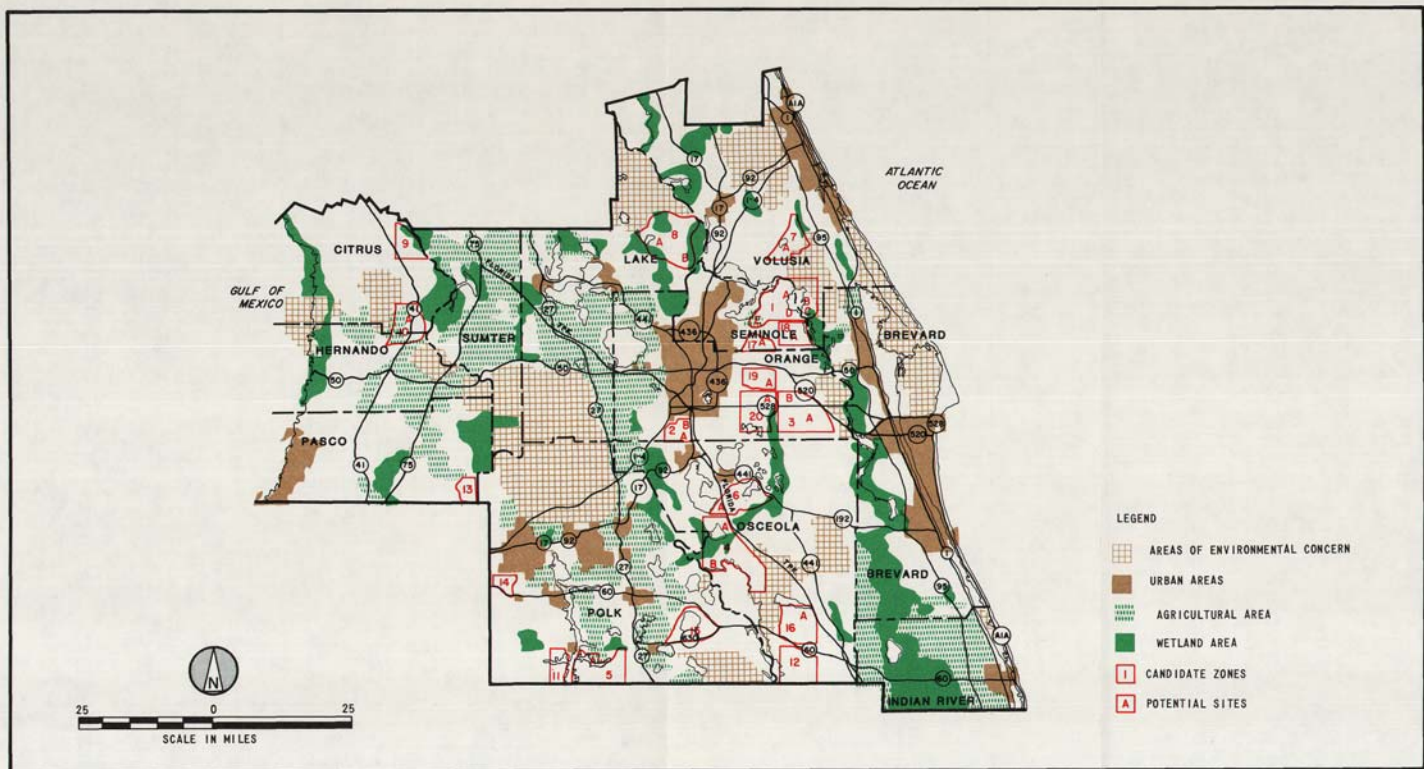


FIGURE 8.1-6. CANDIDATE ZONES AND POTENTIAL SITES IN RELATION TO EXCLUSION AREAS

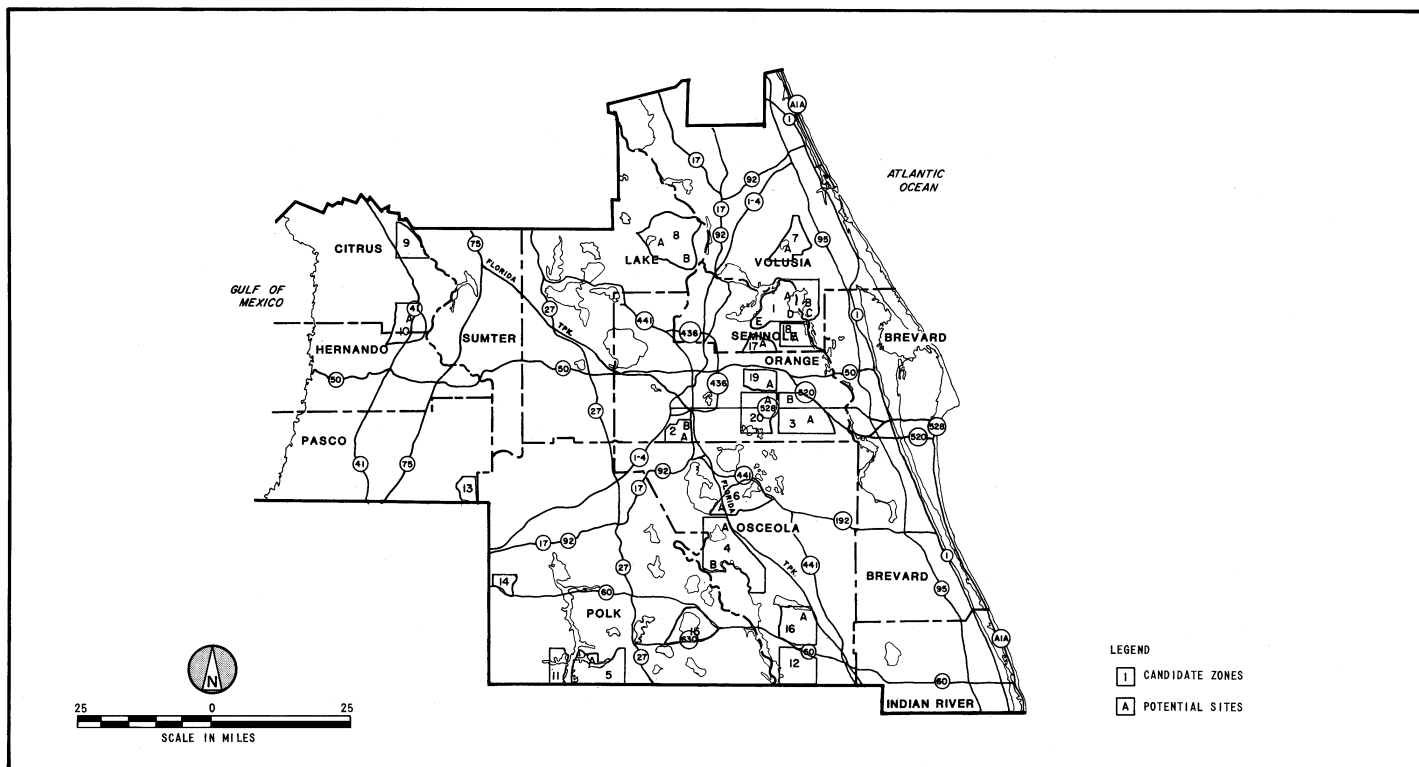


FIGURE 8.1-7. CANDIDATE ZONES AND POTENTIAL SITES

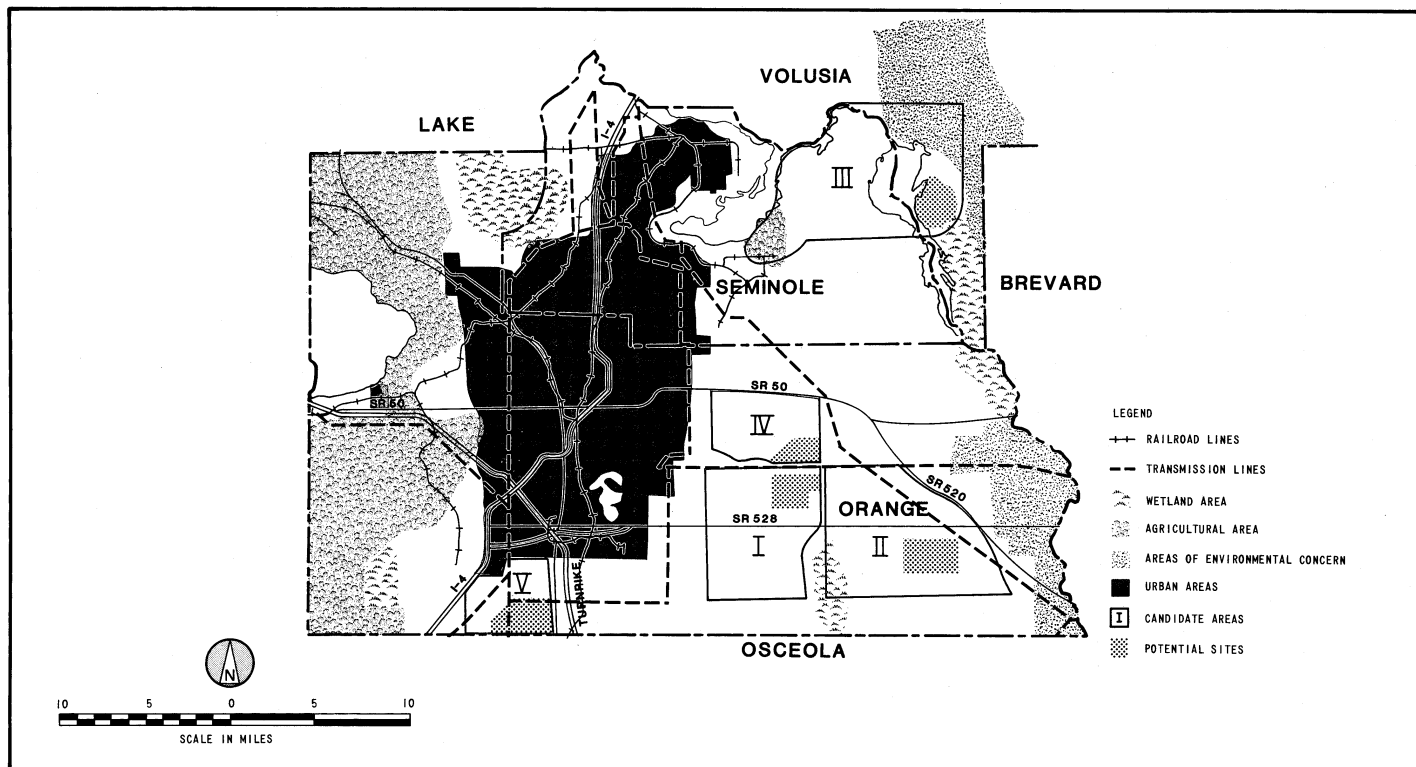


FIGURE 8.1-8. CANDIDATE POWER PLANT SITES

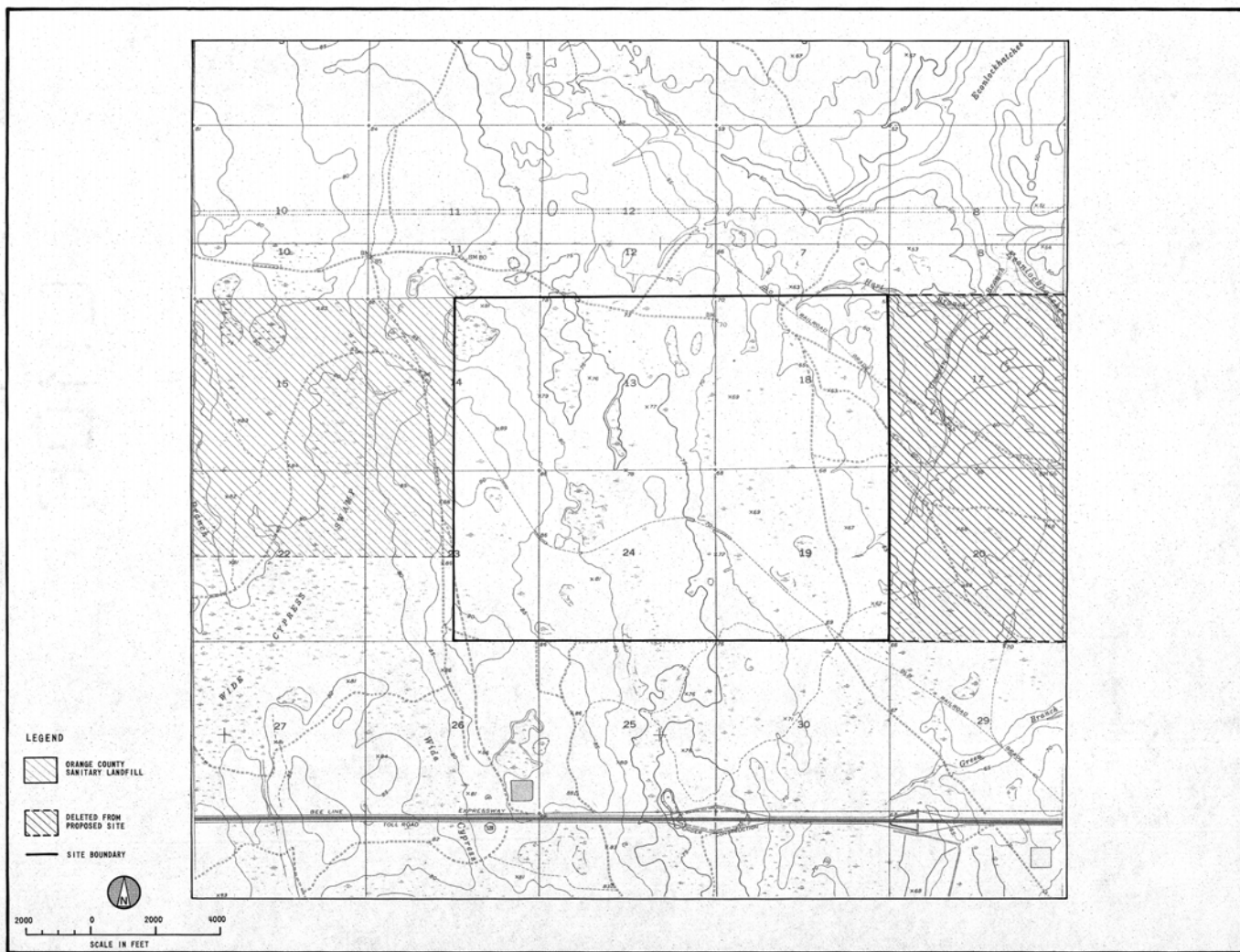


FIGURE 8.1-9. CANDIDATE SITE 20A-ECONLOCKHATCHEE SOUTH

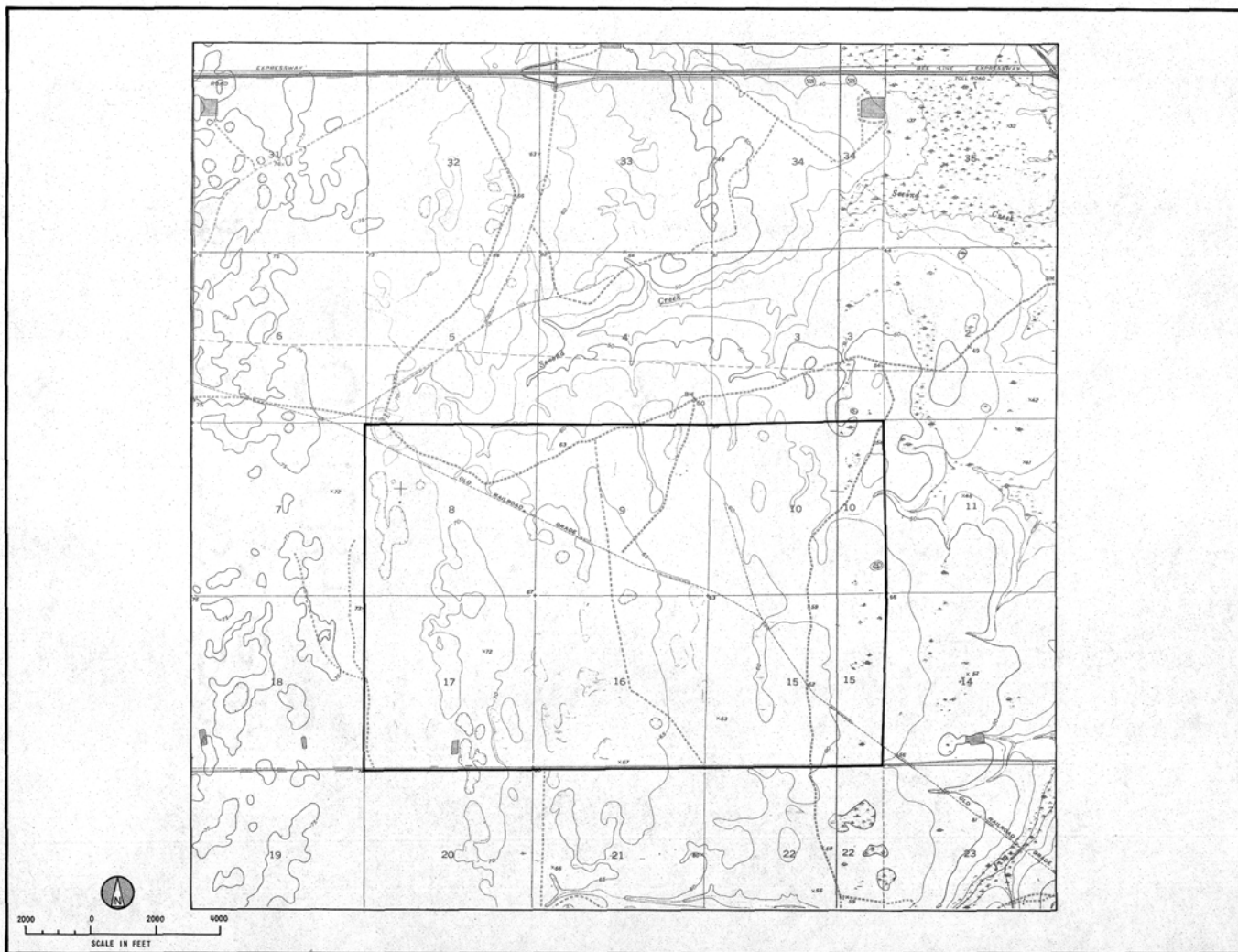


FIGURE 8.1-10. CANDIDATE SITE 3A SOUTHEAST ORANGE COUNTY

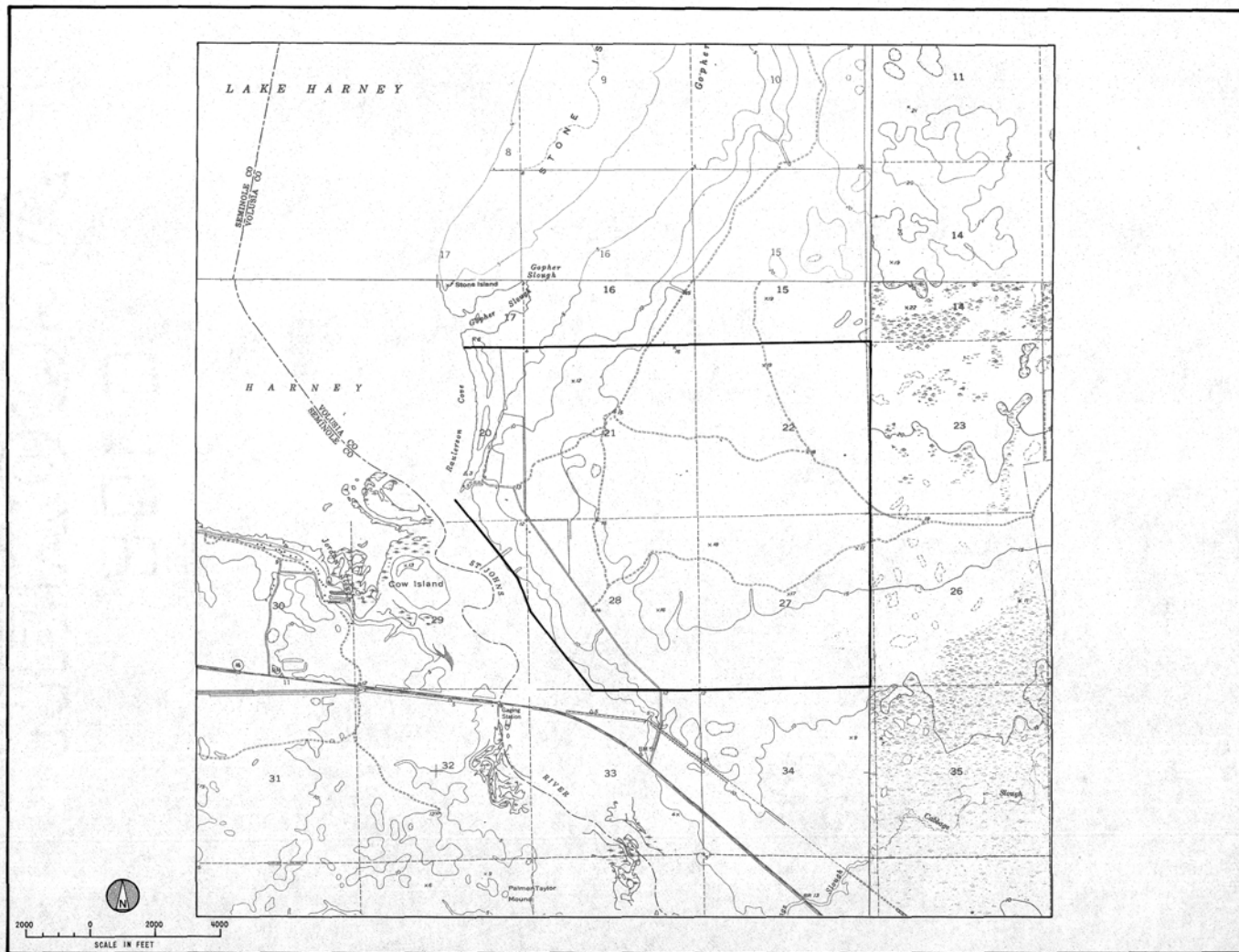


FIGURE 8.1-11. CANDIDATE SITE 1C LAKE HARNEY SOUTHEAST

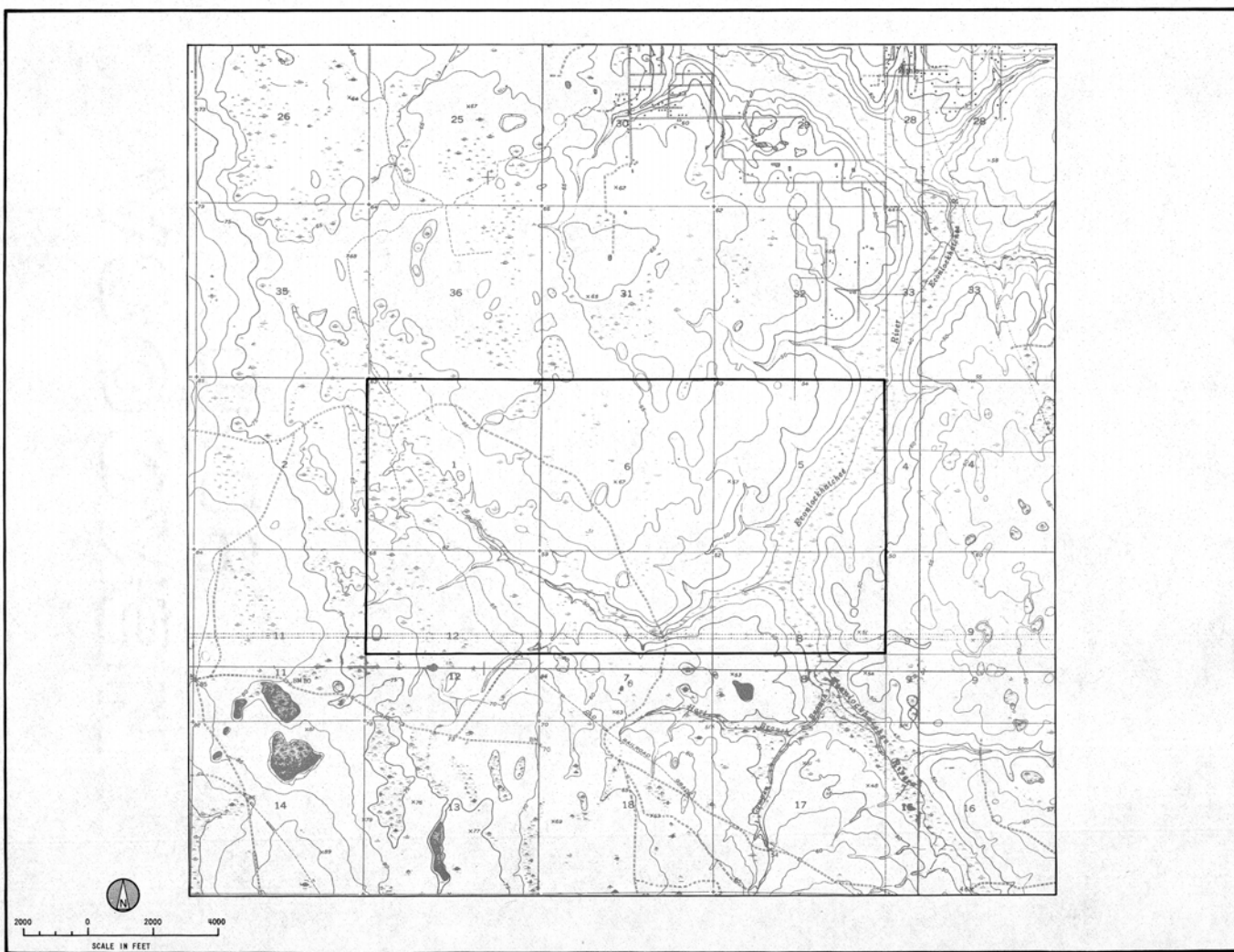


FIGURE 8.1-12. CANDIDATE SITE 19A
ECONLOCKHATCHEE NORTH

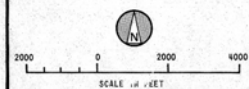


FIGURE 8.1-13. CANDIDATE SITE 2A SHINGLE CREEK

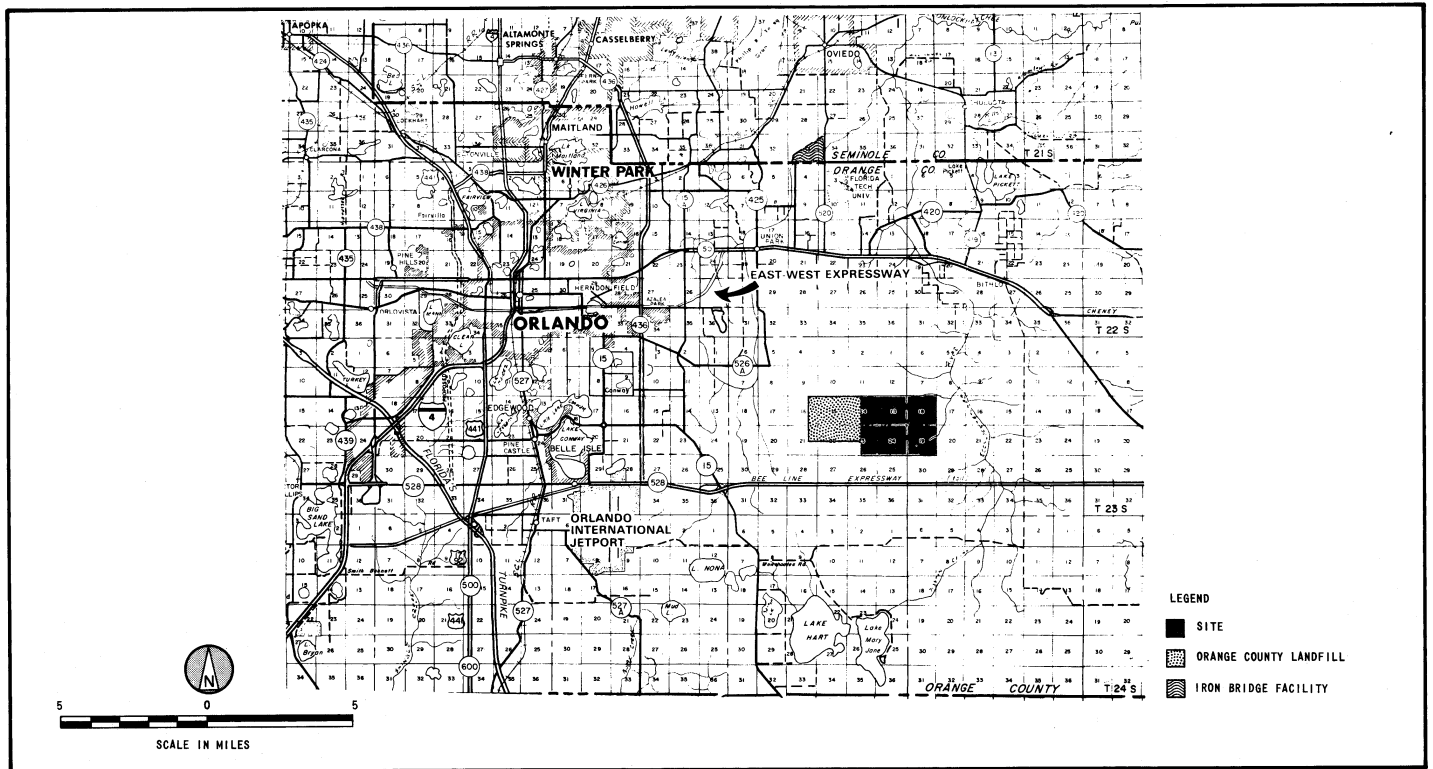


FIGURE 8.1-14. PROPOSED

8.2 ALTERNATIVE FUELS ANALYSIS

Recent amendments to the Florida Electrical Power Plant Siting Act have prescribed a separate Need for Power Document to be submitted to the Public Service Commission. This new document contains those materials previously in Section 1.0 and 8.2 of the Site Certification Application. The alternative fuel analysis for the Curtis H. Stanton Energy Center Unit 1 is presented in a separate Need for Power Document which was submitted to the Public Service Commission at the same time this Application was submitted to the Department of Environmental Regulation. The reviewer is directed to that document for any information which would previously have been included in Section 8.2.
