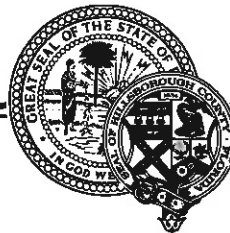
In reviewing the information attached to your letter of June 19, 1992, I am unable to make a definite decision based on the enclosed listing. The material was not submitted by an engineer registered in the State of Florida as required by Florida Administrative Code Rule 17-8. The items listed on the enclosure to your letter indicates that the water treatment device may be a sewage treatment system. Section 193.621(4), Florida Statutes specifically excludes "any public or private domestic sewerage system or treatment works" from assessment as a pollution control device.

Either Lykes gets a professional engineer to certify that this is an industrial waste treatment device or I would recommend denial of their request.

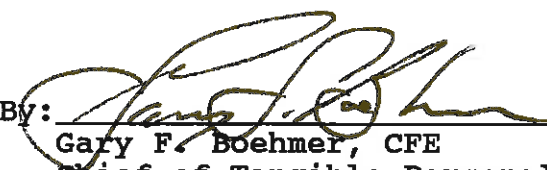
Dear Mr. Oven:
