We are in receipt of your Return for the year 1994 for your facility at the above address. Please refer to Section 193.621, Florida Statutes. As provided in Subsection (6), we are in doubt as to whether your entire facility qualifies as "pollution control devices" as you have claimed. We are therefore referring the matter to the successor agency to the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation for a recommendation and are hereby notifying you as to this action.

Hamilton S. Oven, P.E. at the DER, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, FL 32399-2400, is the person whom you should contact. You must follow the procedures outlined in Chapter 17-8 of the Florida Administrative Code. You should begin by having your Florida registered professional engineer determine which portions of your facility qualify as "pollution control devices" in accordance with that Rule and be prepared to so certify under seal to the DER.
