The Southwest Florida Water Management District (District) has reviewed additional information submitted by the Licensee in an email dated April 25, 2016, in response to the questions/comments included in our April 19, 2016 completeness letter. The submitted information includes an application for modification of Water Use Permit (WUP) No. 20007259.004 to reflect a new boundary that excludes the solar generation facility project area and a statement indicating that protective bollards will be installed at well numbers 2 and 3 which were permitted under this WUP and are located along the boundary of the project area.
