FINAL ORDER MODIFYING CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION

Dear Mr. Klemans:

The Florida Siting Board issued a Site Certification Gainesville Regional Utilities' (GRU) Deerhaven Generating Station (Deerhaven) on May 16, 1978, authorizing the construction and operation of a 250 MW coal-fired steam generator (Unit 2), a 75 MW natural gas-fired simple cycle combustion turbine (Unit 3), and ancillary facilities, in Alachua County. The Department of Environmental Protection (Department) has modified the Conditions of Certification (Conditions) for Deerhaven by Final Order on nine other occasions.

Pursuant to §403.516(1)(c), Florida Statutes (F.S.), the Department has initiated a modification to Deerhaven's Conditions to incorporate a uniform set of General Conditions consistent with recent Site Certifications and to update various Conditions to reflect recent Rule and General Condition language changes.

On March 2, 2020, all parties to the certification proceeding were provided notice of the Department's intent to modify the Conditions for Deerhaven. On March 5, 2020, notice of the Department's intent to modify the Conditions for Deerhaven was also published in the Florida Administrative Register (FAR).

Pursuant to §403.516, F.S., and Rule 62-17.211, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), all parties to the certification proceeding have 45 days from the issuance of notice in which to file a written objection to the modification. Pursuant to §403.516, F.S., and Rule 62-17.211, F.A.C., any person who is not already a party to the certification proceeding and whose substantial

interests will be affected by the requested modification has 30 days from the date of publication of the public notice in the FAR to object in writing. Failure to act within the timeframe constitutes a waiver of the right to become a party.

These timeframes have expired, and the Department did not receive any objections to the modification. The final version of the modified Conditions (including attachments) can be viewed and obtained from the following website:

Any party to this Order has a right to seek judicial review of it pursuant to §120.68, F.S. by filing a Notice of Appeal, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection in the Office of General Counsel, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, M.S. 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal, accompanied by the applicable filing fees, with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection.
